

Company finds funds for Crump couple

A Crump couple learned that not everything that sounds too good to be true is a scam.

James and Aimee Kilburn recently received in excess of \$10,000 through Snow Creek Funding Group, a six-year-old company based in Walnut Hill, Illinois.

James said he was skeptical when he was first contacted about coming into a windfall, but “we finally realized it was the real thing.”

Steve Bundy, the company’s managing director, said Snow Creek specializes in finding unclaimed funds such as inheritance money, trust funds, lock boxes and escrow accounts. Researchers then try to track down who the money belongs to and obtain written permission to recover their funds.

The owner of the found money is not asked in advance for any payment or personal information, he stressed.

“If we are successful in collecting a claim, then we charge a percentage of whatever we can recover. Basically, if the person who hires us to reclaim their money doesn’t get paid, we don’t get paid,” he said.

Bundy said Snow Creek has recovered more than \$500,000 so far.
